At Paws for Life, we need your blessings of donations so that we can continue to give dogs shelter and help find them loving homes.



Every year, almost 4 million dogs enter shelters nationally. Approximately one-third of them never reach their forever homes. At **Paws for Life**, we do everything within our power and means to lower this number by rescuing as many helpless dogs as we can from an undeserving fate.

In 2014, Paws for Life successfully adopted 224 dogs from doggy death row into loving homes where they belong.

These dogs had no say in their fate – most had been in a loving home and lost that home through no fault of their own. An owner who passed away or a family lost their home. Others were unclaimed strays and still others were left behind when they were no longer convenient. All of them met the same fate, ***without a voice*** ... abandoned, forgotten and just a number whose number was about to be called. ***It is up to all of us to be their voice.***

As a **volunteer-only facility**, we put our hearts and souls into our passion. Our payment comes from seeing these dogs transform; from sad and scared eyes in high kill shelters, to recognizing they are safe at our kennel; as we put those who have been kept in small cages with no sunlight and no room to run into one of our exercise yards and watch them ***run and jump with joy***; when a dog and family adopt each other, and our ultimate reward in updates we receive – pictures and stories of the dogs in their forever homes.



Once a dog gets to our facility, it is spayed/neutered, brought up-to-date on shots, microchipped and provided with whatever other veterinary care is needed. We get to know the dog and what kind of family would be the best match. Every dog that is adopted allows us to repeat the process and save another dog.


